

THE NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY ODISHA (REFUND OF FEES ON WITHDRAWAL) RULES, 2013

Without prejudice to the generality of the powers under the National Law University Odisha Act, 2008, (Act 04 of 2008) the National Law University Odisha makes the following rules, to govern the refund of fee on withdrawal by any student.

PART I
PRELIMINARY

1. Short Title, Application and Commencement: These rules may be called the National Law University Odisha (Refund of Fees on Withdrawal) Rules, 2013.
2. All the students of National Law University Odisha shall be governed by these rules.
3. These rules shall come into force from June 24, 2013.
4. Unless otherwise specified the words and phrases used in these rules shall carry their ordinary meaning.

PART II
WITHDRAWAL

5. Subject to these rules, every student who got admitted to the National Law University Odisha shall have the right to withdraw her/his candidature from the University. Provided that, no student shall have a right to withdraw once her or his admission is cancelled by the University as per the rules of the University.

Provided further that, no student shall be entitled for withdrawal, if she or he has been expelled or rusticated from the University.

PART III
REFUND

6. Subject to rules under Parts II and V of these rules, every student shall get refund of the fee including the refundable deposits paid by her or him on withdrawal.

PART IV
PROCEDURE FOR WITHDRAWAL

7. A candidate who is desirous of withdrawing from the University shall apply to the Registrar in writing.
8. Upon such application she or he shall collect the necessary no dues certificate forms from the office of the Registrar and submit the duly filled in forms along with the details pertaining to dues, if any, from the Library, Accounts Department, Mess committee and any other committee (s) as notified by the University from time to time.

PART V
DEDUCTIONS

9. Any candidate who fails to complete the admission formalities as per University rules shall forfeit Rs. 5000/- as administrative fee (which will be adjusted, in due course, towards the total fee payable) paid her/him.
10. If any candidate withdraws herself/himself after taking admission, she or he shall forfeit the tuition fee (Rs. 1, 00,000/-) in addition to Rs. 5000/- as administrative fee.
11. In case of a candidate who is withdrawing after the elapse of one month from the date of admission, she or he shall forfeit the total fee except the refundable deposits.
12. Notwithstanding anything stated in this rules, the Vice-Chancellor may, in his discretion, order a lesser amount of deduction or waive the deductions but for the actual charges.
